



Coaching Development Policy

Policy:

Background:

The Oakville Curling Club is committed to the development of its Coaches and programs. The Oakville Curling Club will subsidize to a maximum of \$1000. in total per fiscal year, towards courses offered by the Ontario Curling Association for Coaching development per season.

Key Principles:

1. Subsidiary funds for coaches who complete the training, and will be involved with running either the Little Rock or Bantam/Junior program, will be allocated from the Junior Development Fund
2. The Oakville Curling Club will pay up to a maximum of 50% of one course per person/per season

Procedures:

1. Members requesting subsidy are to submit a written request to the General Manager by December 1st of the season in which the training was taken
 - a. Proof of payment is required with submission
 - b. Funds will not be issued until after December 1st
 - c. Member must be registered in good standing to be eligible for funds
2. Subsidy is open only to registered members of the Oakville Curling Club
 - a. Excludes Little Rock, Bantam, Junior, and Social members
3. Subsidy may be requested for a maximum of one course per member, per season
4. For coaches who will not be involved in running either the Little Rock or Bantam/Junior program, in return for subsidy of funds, Coaches are required to volunteer for a minimum of 1 (one) Oakville Curling Club 6-week Learn to Curl Trial Program
